COMMUNICATION PLAN

Introduction

Waterbury Generation LLC (WatGen) is constructing a 96 megawatt (MW) peaking electric generating plant (Project) at 725 Bank Street in Waterbury, CT. This Communication Plan (Plan) is required as part of the Community Benefit Agreement and is designed to keep the community informed on the construction and operation of the Project. FirstLight Power Resources, Inc. (FirstLight) will manage the Communication Plan on behalf of WatGen.

The objective of the Plan is to insure:

- That adequate notice and means of communication with surrounding communities and stakeholders is established and maintained by the Project; and
- That complaints and concerns regarding the construction and operation of the Project are promptly and appropriately addressed.

Elements of the Plan

Community Liaison Officer:

The Community Liaison Officer (CLO) is Jim Ginnetti, Vice President of External Affairs for FirstLight. The CLO is responsible for the implementation of the Plan.

Project Website:

The Project Website (http://www.firstlightpower.com/generation/waterbury_generation.asp) will be the primary tool for the posting and dissemination of Project information on a timely basis and will be updated as needed to reflect changes and significant events. The website will include contact information for the CLO and an opportunity to email questions directly to the CLO. At a minimum the website will also include the following information:

- Copies of all official stack test results from the Project submitted to the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection (DEP)
- Links to the Energy Information Administration website which contains monthly and annual data on the Project's generation and fuel consumption
- Links to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Clean Air Markets website which contains data on the Project's operating hours and emissions

In the event that there are any public service announcements made regarding the Project, the following list of media outlets will be utilized for dissemination of such announcements.

Additional Notifications Specified in Community Benefit Agreement:

Prior to commencement of commercial operation, the company will meet with one representative from each of the eight intervenor representatives to describe its Emergency Action Plan and this Communication Plan.

The company will also provide notification to the intervenors of any application to the Connecticut Department of Public Utility Control (DPUC) for approval to change ownership or control of the WatGen Facility.

On or before 90 days after commencement of commercial operations, WatGen shall provide a tour of the WatGen Facility to the Intervenor Representatives. In addition, WatGen will provide such tours on an annual basis at the request of the Intervenor Representatives.

WatGen will also post on its web-site copies of any reports of any emergency or malfunction of the equipment described in the Final Permit that is required by the Final Permit to be submitted to the CT DEP at the request of the Intervenor Representatives.

The eight intervenors, the organizations they represent, and their mailing addresses at the time of the signing of the Community Benefit Agreement can be found in Exhibit A. Those parties will inform the company of changes to the representatives or their contact information.
