



General Information Relating to Munn's Ferry Boat Camping Area

Facilities

- There are four designated tent sites and one adirondack shelter.
- Pit toilets are available.
- Water is not available, campers must bring their own water.
- Trash pickup is provided.
- Wood for modest campfires is provided.
- Each site contains a trash barrel, picnic table, hibachi, and campfire ring.

Access

- All access to the campground will be from the river only.
- The dock is not installed until mid - June.
- All supplies must be brought in by watercraft only.
- Campers should plan on arriving before 7:00 pm.

Length of Stay

- A maximum stay of two nights are allowed. (Holidays excepted)
- Individuals may only book the same site twice in the same season.
- Campers must leave site by 11:00 am on day of departure

Prices

- Tent sites \$22/night, one family or four people per site. All tent sites have a designated 12' X 12' area. Plan one tent per site, it is our experience that 2 tents will not fit on the 12'X12' designated site
- Adirondack Shelter \$30/night, two families or one organized group (Scouts, Camp, Church, etc.)
LIMIT 12 PER GROUP.

Reservation Procedures

Reservations

- Munn's Ferry is available for camping from Memorial Day weekend to Columbus Day. Reservations will be accepted 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Wednesday - Friday beginning on the first Wednesday in April by calling (413) 863-9300.
- You will be required to make deposit for the entire stay either by cash, VISA/MASTERCARD, or send a **check payable to: Northfield Mountain within 10 days** of making the reservation. **Send payment to: Northfield Mountain, 99 Millers Falls Road, Northfield, MA 01360, Attention: Munn's Ferry Reservations.** Receipt of this payment will secure your reservation. Be sure to include the date of your reservation on the check
- You will be asked to provide your boat registration number and model at the time of your call, paddle craft use make, model and color.
- Campers will need to present an ID or confirmation to the Patrol Ranger for reservation verification.
- Campers making reservations without the 10 day lead time will be required to pay to the Patrol Ranger the entire fee upon arrival.
- Campers reserving one night may not automatically expect to extend their reservation to include an additional night stay upon arrival. Additional extensions will be based on site availability, if any.

Cancellations/Refunds

- Full payment is refundable up to 7 days prior the start of your reservation.
- No refunds for cancellations made with less than 7 days prior to check-in date or due to inclement weather.
- Reservation changes are subject to a \$10.00 processing fee.
- We reserve the right to close/evacuate the campground.

Campground Use Rules

- Intended for family use, loud or abusive language, behavior or conduct will not be tolerated.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
- Quiet hours between 10:00 pm and 8:00 am.
- All tents to be pitched on designated areas, designated areas for tents are 12' X 12'
- All campfires kept modest and contained in designated fire rings.
- Cutting or collecting firewood is prohibited.
- Swimming is not allowed from the dock or shores of the campground.
- Pets must be kept on a leash, picked up after, and attended at all times. Problem or noisy pets will be asked to leave with their owners.
- Radios levels must be kept at low volumes at all times. (Such that they are not heard at other sites)
