MICRO-SPIKES OR SNOWSHOES WITH CRAMPONS & STUDED TIRE FAT BIKES



February 17, 2021

The freezing rain and rain we received on Feb. 16, has created a glazed, icy surface. The depth of the snow base is **too shallow for grooming at this time**, so walking with snowshoes or micro-spikes is recommended.

Fat tire bikes with studs may spin the trails today and Thursday. The forecast is for below freezing temperatures to remain through the weekend with snow possible Thursday night.

We'll evaluate and update this report after the storm. Future grooming will be done occasionally depending on snow depth and conditions.

Trails will be closed to mountain bikes and horses through the end of mud season, typically mid-May.
