

Connecticut River Tour Boat Captain



Job Summary:

Spend your summer cruising the Connecticut River in beautiful Western Massachusetts for our 2023 season. As the captain of our 2017 40 X 14 Pontoon style vessel with a capacity of 51 passengers, you will depart three times a day (11:00 AM/ 1:15 PM/ 3:00 PM) for a 1 1/2 hour round trip tour. A Second Mate provides the 45 minute narration and helps with docking and boarding of the vessel. Full time or part time position available, weekends preferred. Typically, cruises start mid-June and run until Columbus Day. Housing may be included. A minimum 25 ton Masters license is required.

Job Responsibilities:

- Oversee vessel and passenger safety
- Assist with customer boarding
- Facilitate pleasant customer interactions
- Ensure customer satisfaction and safety at all times
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Follow safety procedures in order to ensure protection of passengers and vessel
- Ability to safely navigate waterways
- Maintain accurate log book entries
- Perform safety training drills with staff
- Maintain cleanliness and professional appearance of vessel
- Assist with maintenance of the vessel as needed
- USCG 25-ton license required (minimum)
- Weekends required
- Pre-employment and on-going random drug testing required for all marine personnel
